BEHAVIOUR POLICY

In addition to our behaviour policy which is available on the school website, we have outlined what we expect of all children to ensure the health and safety of everyone during the Covid-19 pandemic. Children are expected to:

- Wash hands and use anti-bacterial gel as directed by school staff.
- Follow the guidance about coughing and sneezing safely into a tissue or elbow and put tissues into the bin immediately and wash hands. Try not to touch their faces.
- Use toilets safely, wash hands and leave clean for the next child. Tell an adult if the toilet or hand-washing area is not clean (toilets will be checked and cleaned regularly during the day). Only one child is permitted in the toilets at any time.
- Work at their own desk and ask permission to leave their seat (Years 2 - 6).
- Play in the area of the playground allocated to their class.
- Not touch each other or adults.
- Tell an adult if they need help, are worried or upset about anything.
- Come to school every day in school uniform, with a bottle of water.
- Follow the instructions of adults.
- Follow our school motto, 'We Care, We Share, We Believe, We Achieve'.

We will risk assess any child who may find it difficult to follow these expectations and provide additional support as needed.

We will contact parents if we have any concerns about a child's behaviour.
