

Childeric Live Teaching Protocols

- Two school adults will always be present, before children join the meeting
- School adults will be the last to leave the live lesson
- All live lessons must take place in appropriate areas of the house e.g. not in bedrooms
- If possible, the 'blurring of backgrounds' tool should be used or there should be a neutral background
- Adults and children must be dressed in appropriate clothing e.g. not pyjamas
- All microphones must be muted and children should use the 'hand up' function to gain teachers attention, who will then give them permission to unmute.
- The chat function must only be used for the lesson purposes
- All language used must be appropriate both verbally and in the chat; including any family members in the background
- Normal school rules and sanctions apply – children will be asked to leave the 'room' if behaviour is causing distraction
- Parents should use the normal school means of communication with the teacher and not use the live sessions
- Photographs must not be taken of the screen during live sessions
