Trips & Workshops for Year 6

I am writing to let you know about the exciting upcoming trips and workshops that have been organised for Year 6.

Crossing Borders Art Project

Today Year 6 went to the Gallery at Goldsmiths Centre for Contemporary Art to see the work of Eugenio Dittborn, the Chilean artist that has inspired the 'Crossing borders' art project that they have participated in, alongside other schools in Lewisham and in South Africa.

Africa Workshop at Horniman Museum

On Monday 1st November Spider class will be visiting the Horniman Museum and on Tuesday 2nd November Butterfly class will be visiting the Horniman Museum. They will be taking part in a workshop linked with their topic about Africa. They will be leaving school at 9.20 am and should return by 1.30 pm. They will be travelling by train. Your child needs to bring a packed lunch. If they receive free school meals then a packed lunch can be ordered from school.

Junior Citizen Event

On Friday 5th November **Spider class** will be going to the Lee Green Fire Station to participate in the Junior Citizen Event. They will be leaving school at 12.15 pm and **should return by 3.45 pm**. They will be travelling by bus. Your child needs to bring a packed lunch which will be eaten in school before they leave. If they receive free school meals then a packed lunch can be ordered from school.

On Thursday 11th November **Butterfly class** will be going to the Lee Green Fire Station to participate in the Junior Citizen Event. **They need to arrive at school for 8.45 am** to leave promptly by 8.55 am. They should return by 12.45 pm and will have their lunch in school as normal. They will be travelling by bus.

Some of the topics that the Junior Citizen Event will cover include: Fire safety, Personal/Internet safety, Crime and consequences and Travel safety. We have found this event to be very beneficial for our pupils in the past and think that it is important that all children attend.

Drumming and Capoeira Workshop

On Tuesday 9th November Year 6 will be participating in a drumming and capoeira workshop with the Africa Experience Company as part of their topic about Africa. This is a really enjoyable workshop for the children and we know that the children look forward to taking part.

Hate Crime Workshop

On Tuesday 16th November Year 6 will be participating in a Disability Bullying and Hate Crime Workshop organised by the Lewisham Speaking Up Advocacy Project. Our pupils have attended these workshops before and we found that they were very informative about these important issues.

As you can see, your child is receiving a range of experiences in addition to their learning in class in the next few weeks. We think it is important to offer as many opportunities as possible to our pupils and hope that your child will find these trips and workshops interesting and informative.

School is subsidising the cost of these trips and workshops as some are expensive, but we are asking that you pay £10 towards the cost via your child's ParentPay account. Please make payment by Wednesday 3rd November. We are only able to offer these opportunities if parents support us by paying towards them.

If you have previously completed the form indicating that you can accompany school trips then we will contact you if we need you to attend the Horniman Museum trip or the Junior Citizen trip.

We will take photographs of the children on these trips and at these workshops and will post them on our Twitter and Instagram so you will be able to see them participating.

Please complete the slip below if your child will require a school packed lunch. **Your child is only entitled to a school packed lunch if they receive free school meals.** You only need to return the slip if you are requesting a school packed lunch.
